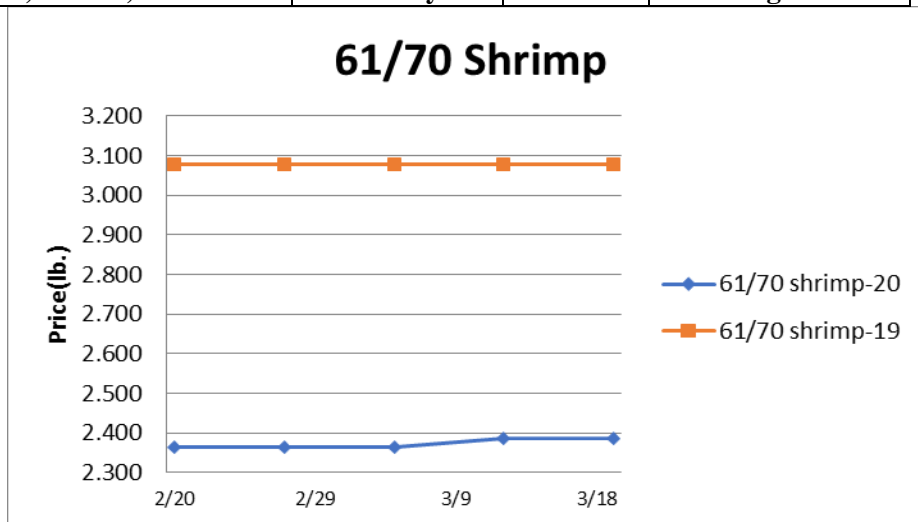

Seafood - The snow crab markets remain expensive. U.S. imports of snow crabs during January were down 20% from the previous year. However, snow crab demand is expected to be shortened considerably in the coming weeks due to restaurant operation restrictions throughout the U.S. This could bring some short-term relief to snow crab prices. However, once the restaurant industry resumes full operations, snow crab demand is expected to escalate. The snow crab markets are likely to be erratic during the spring.
